


Definition of simulation

1: the act or process of simulating

2: a sham object : COUNTERFEIT

3a: the imitative representation of the functioning of one system or process by means of the functioning of another

b: examination of a problem often not subject to direct experimentation by means of a simulating device

: something that is made to look, feel, or behave like something else especially so that it can be studied or used to train people







Suppress Questions


 "Not like the flu" despite EVERY model of infection at University of Washington and Johns Hopkins being 100% based on the flu

Focus on 1 story

- Daily "infection" and count despite evidence that:
 - There are not adequate or reliable tests
 - No scientific evidence for distancing, masks, or treatment other than computer models with disproven assumptions

Monitor Response

- Narrative Propagation
 - Recitation of "Experts"
 - Denial of "Experts"
- Behavior Compliance
 - Social Distancing
 - Self-harm (Unemployment)
 - Business destruction
 - Enthusiasm over bribes (checks)
- Divergent
 - Other topics Vaccination, 5G, wealth distribution, N.W.O., Conspiracy, etc.
 - Revolt
 - Submission








































